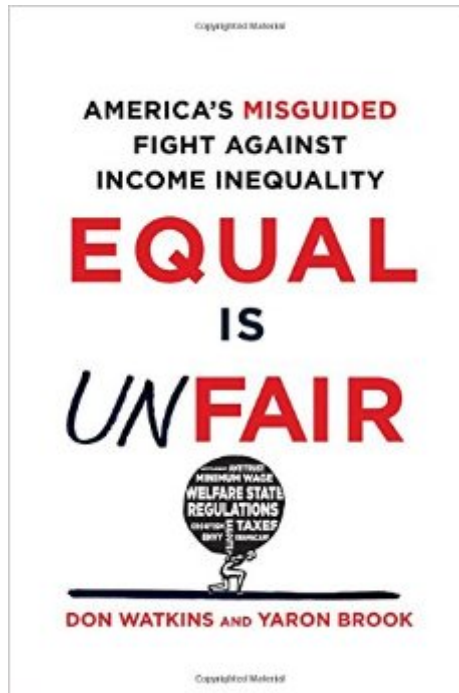


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Equal Is Unfair: America's Misguided Fight Against Income Inequality

Everyone in the political mainstream approves of both equality and fairness. Unfortunately both of those things are individually complex--making things equal or fair in one respect makes them

unequal or unfair in other respects--and the two can often conflict. About five years ago, however, a strand of political thought emerged that targeted inequality the major social problem. The movement was possibly ignited by the Occupy Wall Street protests, and it gained a lot of momentum from Thomas Piketty's 2013 bestseller, *Capital in the Twenty-First Century*. In the simple version, a small group of people (conventionally known as "the 1%," although in practice referring to anything from the richest 25% to the richest 0.01% of the population depending on context) monopolizes all the good things: income, wealth, consumption, power and prestige; and uses its favored position to advance its interests, which includes keeping the 99% and their children from reaching the 1%. From this point of view it doesn't matter much how you measure inequality or whether the 1% acquired their status by merit, luck or crime. Inequality itself destroys civil society and leads to either revolution or oligarchy. Most people who oppose this view accept the premise that inequality is bad in itself, but argue (a) things are not as unequal as protesters claim and (b) some inequality is necessary to reward merit, hard work and useful contributions to economic growth. *Equal is Unfair* takes a much harder line, as is obvious from its title. It's even clearer in contrapositive form, the book argues that a fair society must be unequal.

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
