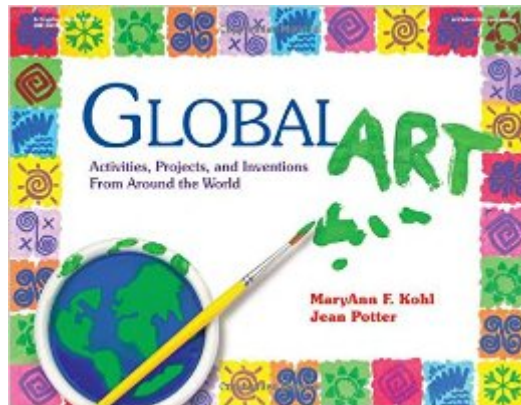

I love how the chapters are organized by continents, and how the projects are not so much copying crafts from different countries, but actually incorporate history and inventions and all kinds of things from different countries into simple, easy to do art projects. The chapter on Antarctica is a kick! It's all projects about snow and ice and white paint. My kids love it! Works for all ages, too, from preschool through about age twelve I would think.

We really like this craft book - it's one of the better ones we own. The materials are easy to find, the crafts are easy to do... and it's fun! If you're looking to supplement your homeschooling curriculum or just want a great book overflowing with ideas for rainy days and weekends, get this book.

I enjoy all of MaryAnn F. Kohl's books, and this one is a little different than her others as it has a bit more in the way of finished products, though they are all arrived at by discovering and creating. Still, this book works well for those older kids who want a little more "fact" in their art. My favorite chapter revolves around Asian projects, in particular those from Japan.

I was looking for art projects to compliment a diversity curriculum...while this is perfect for an art class, I am only able to use a few of the projects. Most of the projects are geared for grade schoolers and up (5 years and up).I am keeping the book to compliment my educational library at home and in the classroom. You might want to check out "Hands around the world" (I rating this one 5 stars!).

I was looking for a book to give ideas to both my homeschooled 2nd and 6th graders. While the book is okay for the second grader, the projects are too simplistic and too easy for an older child. I know it says the book is for 3-6 grade, but I didn't find this to be the case.Also, most of the books mentioned in the Selected Bibliography section were way below a 5th-6th grade level. I was a little disappointed, and I guess I'll have to keep looking for art resources for pre-teens.

This has been a fun book with some unique ideas. The projects mostly use common products that you will probably have on hand. Many projects for a bit younger than my 11 and 13 year old. Clear instructions and pencil drawings of the project so you can 'see' what it should look like.

This book is great for art. I love the pictures and information. The children love the art activities that are in the book. Other books just supply you with color pages, ut this book goes much further, love it!

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
